About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

Unity Church of Arlington, dba, Unity of Arlington, began as a home study group on August 8, 1974, with the encouragement and support of then Unity Church of Dallas minister, Donald Curtis. The group met at several locations until the current location on Bowen Road was purchased on June 3, 1983. Located in the South-Central region of Arlington, our ministry's campus is located just off South Bowen Road, one of the main North-South streets in Arlington. The campus consists of 5 acres which includes a Sanctuary, Administration Building, Garden Lane Center (GLC) and a garage apartment adjacent to GLC. We own all the property outright with no mortgage.

The sanctuary and administration buildings were erected on the property in January 1984. The Garden Lane Event Center property (adjacent to the sanctuary) serves as a space for classes, workshops, fellowship, meetings and special events.

Locality: Arlington, Texas

Our ministry is in the North Texas city of Arlington which today ranks among the 48 most populous cities in the country. Arlington is the 8th most diverse city in the US. With a population of more than 365,000 and spread across 100 square miles, Arlington is located precisely midway between Dallas and Fort Worth and is the largest "mid" city in America. The University of Arlington is a Tier One University, located within a few miles of the church. With massive events and a million things to do and see throughout the year, we are home to the Dallas Cowboys' world-class AT&T Stadium, Six Flags Over Texas & Six Flags Hurricane Harbor, Choctaw Stadium and the Esports Stadium & Expo Center.

We are also home to the 2023 world champion Texas Rangers' new Globe Life Field and Texas Live! entertainment complex, including Live! by Loews upscale hotel resort, International Bowling Museum & Hall of Fame and the Arlington Convention & Visitors Bureau. Coming in 2024, is the National Medal of Honor Museum, Loews Arlington Hotel & Convention Center and One Rangers Way.
