About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

Unity Fort Worth is a community with a willingness to come together in ownership to explore and grow. The community has a deep care for one another, which is especially seen when we rally around members going through a difficult time to provide support and a listening ear. Sunday services are important to us, and we love our talented music ministry. We have an interest in revitalizing programs we have enjoyed in the past, such as gathering in small groups for classes, book studies and gardening. We continue to have a regular group of volunteers out in the community at a mobile food pantry each month.

Our ministry is unique in many ways.

- ★ We recently created an executive director position to handle the administrative responsibilities of the community in order to allow our next senior minister to focus on spiritual leadership, guidance, and development of programs, such as services, classes, groups, special events, pastoral care, and outreach opportunities. With our transitional minister, we have found this to be impactful on the well-being of our leaders.
- ★ Our music ministry is led by a Music Director who is a classically trained pianist and has built a team of talented vocalists and musicians who serve as volunteers. We play a variety of music, from traditional hymns to classical to rock and pop. People are attracted to our community because of our music, particularly our Rock-N-Roll Sundays and seasonal concerts.
- ★ We have an incredible tech team led by congregants with significant experience in the field of engineering. We have a great-quality live stream that allows congregants to attend Sunday service and engage with us online.

Fort Worth is a laid-back city with a diverse community and a thriving cultural district. The weather is warm and sunny the majority of the year with brief cold snaps and wonderful thunderstorms, allowing us to spend much time outdoors enjoying spaces like the Trinity Trails and the Fort Worth Botanic Gardens. We enjoy the western heritage and small feel of Fort Worth compared to larger cities.

The intention behind this decision is to allow the senior minister to focus on spiritual leadership and guidance, co-creating programs such as services, classes, groups, special events, pastoral care, and outreach opportunities, as we collectively strive to focus on caring for ourselves and the community through prayer and meditation, with a renewed expression of outreach into our larger Fort Worth community.
