About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

Unity of Kalamazoo has been providing a positive path for spiritual living for over 100 years. It is known for its openness, community involvement, and support of the LGBTQ+ community. It is a beacon for new thought education and support.

Strong leadership and engaged volunteers have sustained this stable and vital ministry as it continues to evolve. In 2022, our Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion team was launched. A handful of its members and leaders have participated in a series of workshops focused on identifying and eliminating systemic racism. This team also wrote, and the congregation adopted, a Land and Labor Acknowledgement that we affirm weekly along with our Mission, Vision, and Core Values.

The current church property provides a warm, inviting atmosphere for worship, fellowship, educational opportunities, small groups, and youth ministry. Our building has a spacious sanctuary that seats approximately 240. Our lower level includes classrooms, a nursery, meeting space and storage. Our upper level features a commercial kitchen, almost 3,000 square feet for fellowship, and separate meeting and office space.

Locality/Physical Description

Unity of Kalamazoo is located in Kalamazoo, Michigan, a progressive, affordable city of just under 75,000 in the southwest corner of the state – halfway between Detroit and Chicago. As of July 1, 2023, the population of the Kalamazoo–Portage metropolitan area in Michigan was estimated to be 262,215 - making it the sixth largest metropolitan area in Michigan. Kalamazoo was listed by U.S. News & Worlds' Report as one of the top 100 places in America to live in 2024.

Located 45 minutes from South Haven on Lake Michigan and an hour from Warren Dunes State Park, there is easy access to beaches, hiking trails and all the beauty and activities of Lake Michigan. The entire lakeshore is dotted with quaint resort towns that feature shops, marinas, fishing, boating, arts and festivals. The rural area surrounding Kalamazoo has beautiful rolling hills, farms, and vineyards. The beauty of the seasons is a blessing to the soul. Fall in southwestern Michigan is unsurpassed. Winter brings downhill and cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and other outdoor activities.

Kalamazoo is home to Western Michigan University and Kalamazoo College, with opportunities for sporting events, arts, and entertainment. The Gilmore Piano Festival draws world-class performers. There are minor league sports teams, a variety of ethnic restaurants, art fairs and museums. Internationally known global pharmaceutical leader Pfizer has its largest manufacturing facility here and Stryker Corporation is headquartered here. Two large hospital systems and a leading heart center provide excellent medical care.

A special resource for those who live in Kalamazoo is the Kalamazoo Promise, a program that pays up to 100% of tuition and mandatory fees at any in-state public community college or university for those students that attend and graduate high school from Kalamazoo Public Schools.
