## Why does Unity Worldwide Ministries tithe?

Unity Worldwide Ministries' tithes go to individuals or organizations that provide inspiration or support for its functions, mission, leaders, or goals in consciousness. Tithing by Unity Worldwide Ministries home office is guided by the following understandings: Tithing is the giving of 10% of all unrestricted donations received to organizations or individuals who provide inspiration or support to the home office, leadership, or the Unity movement. That giving is not a substitute for purchase of goods or services.
