# **About the Ministry**

#### **OVERVIEW**

Unity of the Valley Spiritual Center evolved from a Study Group and was incorporated in the 1980's. We have had three long-term ministers: Rev. Vic Jenkins, Rev. Micah (Ken) Murdock, and Rev. Dalia Adams. At one time, our ministry served 170 people who attended regularly.

In the 1990's we purchased our own building then enlarged the building in 2010. During this time, we have hosted several regional conferences, community events, in-house celebrations, added a second service on Sunday, established a vibrant youth education program, and during covid pandemic started a successful online service.

Since the pandemic, we've been gradually rebuilding our membership and community outreach.

Our congregation feels like an extended family. We genuinely enjoy coming together and delight in each other's company on Sundays and special events. Putting our Love into Action is a bedrock principle of this congregation; we have a long history of participation by enthusiastic, highly motivated volunteers.







## **LOCALE**

Unity of the Valley Spiritual Center is in Vacaville, California. Vacaville is in Solano County, one of the nine Bay Area Counties. Our Center is about halfway between Sacramento and San Francisco/Oakland Bay Area at the junction of Highways I-80 and I-505. Our ministry serves Vacaville, Fairfield, Dixon, and Winters.

Our area is close to many recreational areas including Lake Tahoe, coastal California, nearby Lake Berryessa, and our own Lagoon Valley Recreational Area.

Vacaville has a rich past, tracing its roots to the early days of pioneers and adventurers. Throughout more than 150 years, Vacaville has maintained a spirit that embraces change yet holds to the traditions of a colorful past. We have a population of 100,000 and yet maintain a small-town atmosphere.

Generations of families have visited Vacaville's Nut Tree area including the Factory Outlets, making it a true stopover along I-80.

Today, Vacaville is a vibrant community in one of the fastest growing areas in California. It has become home to some of the largest and most successful life-science companies in the world, including Lonza, Alza, and Chiron.

Many of Vacaville's citizens either serve or work at the nearby Travis Air Force Base. Its location makes it one of California's most attractive family communities.


